

Minutes of Misener/Margett's Women's Research Centre
June 9, 1992

Planning for the summer months and into the fall of 1992 at the Centre was the main item on the agenda.

Noreen is acting as administrator for the summer and it was decided that because Pat no longer lives in Edmonton that signing authority at Canada Trust will be transferred to Noreen Bell. That would mean that Marilyn Assheton-Smith and Noreen are the signing authorities.

There will be a major mail out to all members of the research centre; the format has not been decided. It was not determined whether a Research Forum would be held in Fall 1992. Requests for Lorraine's document are still arriving.

Two projects are working out of the Centre this summer. One is researching the issue of women whose mother tongue is not English and what happens to them when they experience crisis, whether that be physical violence, psychological violence or sexual abuse. This project will run over the next six months.

The other project is funded by The Canadian Advisory Council on the Status of Women. The purpose of this project is to look into what Canada has accomplished, or not accomplished following the commitments to women's equality at the U.N. Conference in Nairobi in 1985. This project will run until December.

A time for another meeting was not set due, however one will be called to approve the mail out to be done in late summer.
