Example of Indirect Cost Calculation: If the indirect cost rate is 40% of total direct costs for a contract of total value \$100,000, the amount available for budgeted direct costs is \$100,000/1.4 = \$71,430. The indirect costs are $$71,430 \times 0.4 = $28,570$. The sum of these two figures is the total value of the contract.

Indirect Costs of Sponsored Research - University of

Alberta Policy

On March 2 of 1990, the Board of Governors passed the above which has been circulated to all staff members. The relevant allocations are as follows:

Department	29%*
Faculty	9%*
Library	13%
Research Initiatives	9%
Central	40%
	100%

*These are for departmentalized faculties. For non-departmentalized faculties the allocation is 38%.

All applications for grants from any funding agencies that pay indirect costs, such as Alberta Provincial Departments, must include in their budgets a provision for indirect costs. Additionally, it is the responsibility of University of Alberta staff, departmental and faculty administrators to ensure that University of Alberta policy on indirect costs is followed. The University of Alberta will assume no liability for externally sponsored research projects which have not been approved at all appropriate levels - central, departmental and/or faculty, and payment to staff and to students for sponsored research must come from sources duly approved at these levels. Violations of the indirect cost policy will be dealt with in accordance with University procedures.

With regard to a related issue, University staff and departmental faculty administration are reminded that the staff using University facilities and staffing resources for supplementary professional activities are required to reimburse the University for their use (see Faculty Agreement 29.07).

Extra copies of the indirect cost synopsis have been sent to departmental and faculty offices for distribution to new staff and for convenient reference.


Dear Chairperson,
