Enclosed are letters I received after one small broadcast in one small city. You can see the reaction of the people of Canada by those who sent in replies. I found a similar reaction on the 57 speeches I made. The people of Canada have turned against Trudeau and his desire to alter our entire government by forming a new republic type state, instead of the past confederation of provinces, and they will not accept a Charter or Rights which deprives individuals and provinces of property rights.

This is shown in the two provincial elections where opponents of Trudeau were defeated, two byelections (the only ones held) in the safest Liberal ridings in Ontario and Quebec where Trudeau's candidates were defeated; also shown by the Gallop Poll now which indicates that a majority of Canadians are opposed to Trudeau's package. Trudeau was only elected with a majorityoof eight, and at that time, he did not tell them about the Constitution. He got in

through with the support of the NDP and now they are threatening to withdraw that. Eight out of ten Premiers oppose the Constitution and they represent the majority of Canadians. And the Supreme Court's decision supports your own English legal committees' findings that he can not do this without the consent of the Provinces.

THE MAJORITY OF CANADIANS, OUR SUPREME COURT, ARE NOW AGAINST TRUDEAU. AND IF ENGLAND FORCES THIS ON CANADA, CANADIANS WILL NEVER FORGIVE THEM.
