The Women's Resource Centre, on the University of Alberta campus, supports a wide range of services, including housing more than 170 newsletters and periodicals. The majority are published by women's groups, but included are those produced by social planning, education, immigrant, human rights, labour and health groups if they discuss in part issues of concern to women. These publications are available for public perusal at no charge, during the following hours: Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday - 10:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.; Thursday - 10:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Current holdings, which are constantly expanding, are identified in the following alphabetical entries by the notation **periodical**, **newsletter** or **reference**. Each is also identified as an **English**, **French** or **Bilingual** publication. Date of first issue is noted, and when applicable, date of last issue. The designation **KWOC** appears if the publication is indexed in the Canadian Women's Periodicals Index, which is produced at the Resource Centre and available for quick and easy reference to articles on a specific topic or by a particular author.

Additional Material Available

Another major section of the Women's Resource Centre is dedicated to books, reports, essays and articles on subjects of interest to women. An easy-to-operate computer on the premises locates material by title, author or subject. Books may be signed out for two-week periods, with purchase of a \$5 yearly membership.

Pamphlets from more than 100 local, provincial and national groups and organizations are available at the Resource Centre, and a bulletin board detailing events of interest is updated regularly. A referral wheel provides a guide to individuals, professionals and organizations working in a wide variety of areas. Knowledgeable and friendly staff are always present to assist visitors.

The Resource Centre also supports the efforts of the Women's Program, Faculty of Extension (at the same location), in making available information to a growing number of women who register in Women's Program courses each year.


