A feminist analysis of reproductive labour in Canada focusing on the shift from the family to the state. Through an incisive examination of legal enactment of social policy Ursel examines how the State has replaced the family as the constructing agents of patriarchy, and how after a century of change reproductive labour is still the primary responsibility of women.
