Ms. Bonenfant will open the conference Saturday, November 9th with a feminist view of a future Québec society and Ms. Simms will address the CRIAW annual meeting Sunday, November 10th linking the global feminist movement to work on a community level. As well, the presence of representatives of women's groups from Africa, Guyana, Bangladesh and the Philippines will help emphasize how local issues have global manifestations and will demonstrate how Third World women's issues and strategies have relevance for women in Canada.

The main focus of the conference is feminist research currently being carried out across Canada and internationally. Panel discussions, workshops and more than thirty round table groups will look at areas ranging from the generation gap between older and younger feminists, to gender and playfulness, a therapist's and client's experience of feminist therapy, global feminism, women's place in employment, feminism and rural life, career issues for women administrators, and many, many more. In total there will be more than 85 presentations which include film, stained glass, music and more traditional forms of research.

Canadian and international researchers are generating interesting and exciting work and the CRIAW conference is an opportunity for interested persons to learn about and discuss this research. 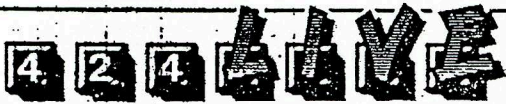

The Morning's News IN BRIEF

A Japanese-owned pulp mill in Northern Alberta is calling on Ottawa to settle the Lubicon Indian Band's land claim. The vice-president of Daisho, Tom Hamaoka, says his company is tired of being drawn into the dispute between the Lubicon and the federal and provincial governments. He told a Chamber of Commerce Economic Outlook Conference that Daisho is not here as a mediator, but is here to do business.

The Edmonton Aboriginal Representative Committee was formed to help maintain a positive relationship between the Indian and Metis people in the city and between other citizens and groups. Yesterday Mayor Reimer announced the committee's plans and said aboriginal concerns in Edmonton have to be dealt with. The committee has planned an open house for October 25th to provide insight into its action plan.

The Business Innovation Centre will be open for one more year thanks to a \$40 thousand grant from City Council. Council also said that there will not be any more money for the centre in the future.

City Council still hasn't given its approval for a downtown concert hall. The matter was referred back to administration, and it will come up before council again on November 19th.

Alberta Liberals are charging that there are senseless bureaucratic hassles for parents of special needs children. Social Service's critic, Betty Hewes says that the Edmonton office of Family and Social Services is refusing to provide assistance for the extra costs associated with the placement of special needs children in after-school care programs. In Calgary the situation is the reverse. Hewes says it's a very human problem, and she is pleading with the government to do what it has said it was going to do. She says the government should be consistent in its Equal Access to Services Program.

There was a dramatic rescue yesterday from the North Saskatchewan River in southwest Edmonton. A 49-year-old woman, who suffers from epilepsy, was reported missing at about 9:30 yesterday morning. During the search, Barry, a three-and-a-half year old police dog, led his trainer, Constable Randy Shriner, down a ravine leading to the river. The woman was spotted in the water, clinging to a boulder. She was rescued and was rushed to the Misericordia Hospital. She is in critical condition, but is improving.

Prime Minister Mulroney says the government can't afford to give farmers everything they want. But, he says, Ottawa will have something for financially-strapped farmers. Mulroney says officials will tell him sometime today what money they can come up with. More than 6,000 farmers and their supporters rallied on the steps of the Manitoba Legislature yesterday to protest low grain prices. The farmers say that it costs more to produce grain than they can sell it for.

Labour Minister, Marcel Denis says that contract negotiations between the post office and postal workers are at the make-it-or-break-it stage. Yesterday, he confirmed reports from union officials that the mediated talks between Canada Post and the Canadian Union of Postal Workers are not going well, despite weeks of mediation. The two major issues still left on the table are job security and the contracting out of postal services. The union is trying to reverse the trend toward part-time workers and contracting out. The postal workers walked out on strike in late August, but returned to the bargaining table after the appointment of mediator Alan Gold. Gold is expected to report to the Labour Minister at the end of this week.

EDMONTON- La 15e conférence de l'Institut canadien de recherches sur les femmes (ICREF) aura lieu à l'hôtel Westin du 8 au 10 novembre prochains, sous le thème **Vision globale, action locale**.

Quelque 400 déléguées pourront entendre les conférencières invitées, Claire Bonenfant, vice-présidente des conseils régionaux à la Fédération des femmes du Québec, et Glenda Simms, présidente du Conseil consultatif canadien sur la situation de la femme. Mme Bonenfant lancera la conférence samedi le 9 novembre en présentant la vision de l'avenir des femmes du Québec dans un Québec où changements

politiques, projet de société et souveraineté se côtoient.

Mme Simms s'adressera aux membres de l'ICREF dimanche le 10 novembre, à propos du lien entre le mouvement des femmes et l'action communautaire. De plus, la présence de représentantes de groupes de femmes de l'Afrique, des Guyanes, du Bangladesh et des Philippines permettra de comparer les problèmes et les stratégies des femmes du Tiers-monde avec ceux des Canadiennes.

La présence de ces dernières explique bien le thème **Vision globale, action locale**. «C'est en observant ce qui se passe ailleurs que l'on peut tirer des leçons, améliorer nos stratégies

et les appliquer dans notre milieu canadien», souligne Mme Marcelline Forestier, coordinatrice du Colloque de l'ICREF.

La conférence portera surtout sur la recherche féministe contemporaine au Canada. Il y aura au-delà de 85 présentations qui traiteront de divers sujets comme l'écart des générations entre les jeunes féministes et les plus âgées, l'expérience de la thérapie féministe pour une thérapeute et une cliente, le féminisme international, la place de la femme dans le marché du travail, le féminisme en milieu rural, les problèmes de carrière pour les administratrices. Ces sujets seront abordés sous forme de panels, d'ateliers et de plus

de trente tables rondes.

Un banquet sera donné le samedi soir. La musique de femme sera en vedette, tout d'abord avec la talentueuse Jennifer Berezan, auteure-compositrice de réputation internationale. Et ensuite avec les Chanteuses féministes d'Edmonton, des femmes de divers milieux qui font toutes preuve de beaucoup d'esprit. La soirée se terminera par une danse, à partir de la plus grande collection multiculturelle de musique de femmes à Edmonton.

Les femmes francophones autant qu'anglophones y sont invitées. Un service de garderie, de traduction simultanée anglais-français et d'interprétation par signes pour les handicapées auditives, seront disponibles.

L'inscription au Colloque comprend toutes les représentations, le dîner samedi et dimanche ainsi que le banquet de samedi. 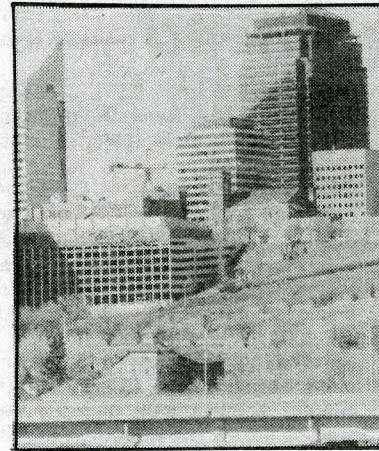

Have a bright, safe Halloween
