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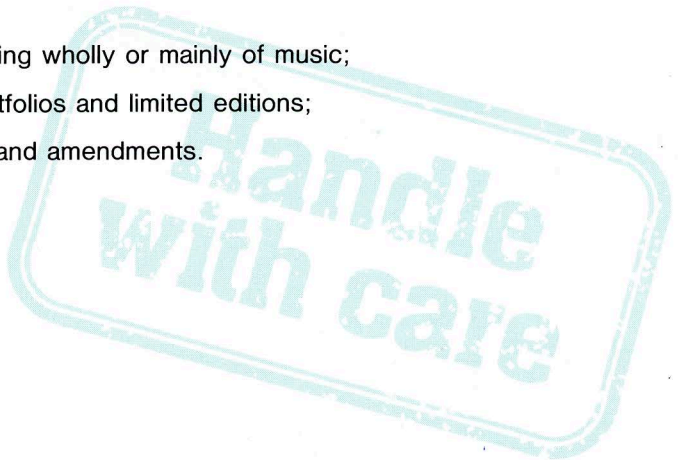
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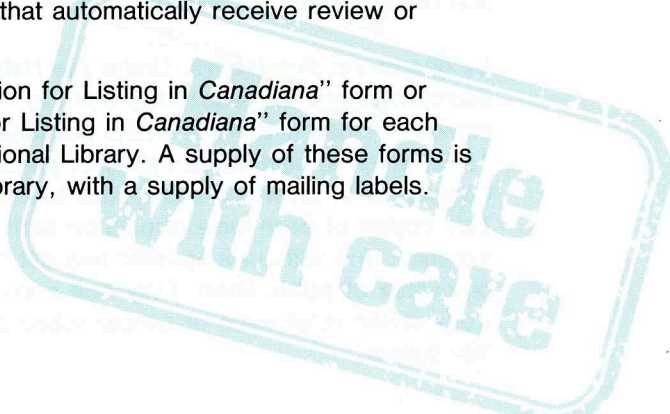
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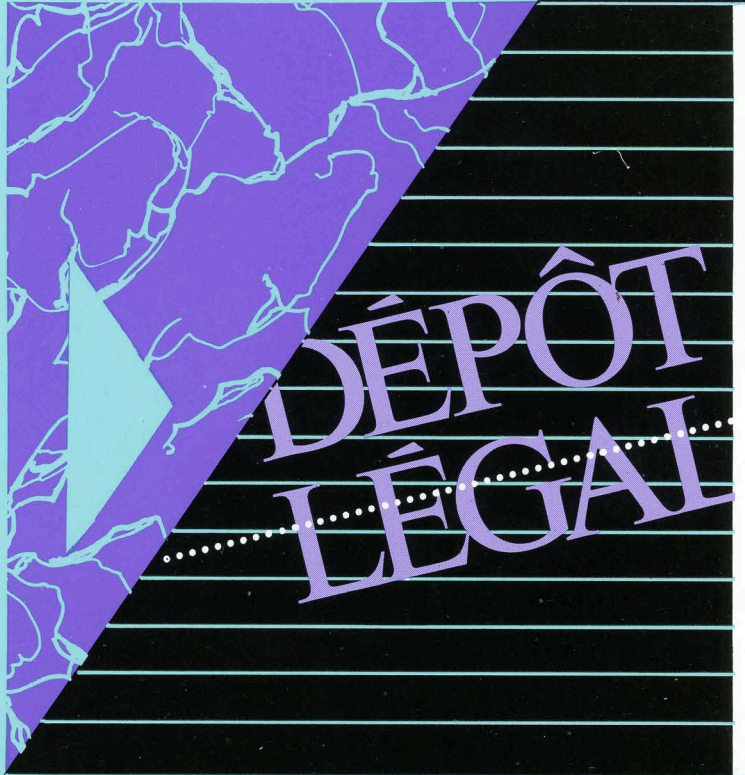
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BIBLIOTHÈQUE NATIONALE DU CANADA: SERVICES OFFERTS AUX ÉDITEURS ET AUX COMPAGNIES D'ENREGISTREMENTS SONORES

Créée en 1953, la Bibliothèque nationale du Canada est le noyau du réseau des bibliothèques du pays. Elle a trois responsabilités principales: promouvoir le développement et l'utilisation des ressources des bibliothèques canadiennes; acquérir, préserver et rendre accessible le patrimoine du pays; appuyer les études canadiennes au bénéfice de tous les Canadiens.

Pour s'acquitter de ses responsabilités, la Bibliothèque nationale met en œuvre plusieurs programmes et services afin d'aider les organismes et les particuliers qui mettent en circulation au Canada des livres, microformes, périodiques et enregistrements sonores:

- **Les programmes ISBN et ISSN**, administrés par la Bibliothèque;
- **Le Programme canadien de catalogage avant publication (CIP)**, coordonné par la Bibliothèque;
- **Canadiana, la bibliographie nationale** des publications et enregistrements sonores, laquelle a été créée et est publiée par la Bibliothèque;
- **Le Programme du dépôt légal**, mis en œuvre par la Bibliothèque.

QU'EST-CE QUE LE DÉPÔT LÉGAL?

En vertu du dépôt légal, des exemplaires des publications et enregistrements sonores canadiens doivent être envoyés à la Bibliothèque nationale.

Le principe sous-jacent au dépôt légal est admis et appliqué à l'échelle internationale. Au Canada, l'obligation du dépôt légal s'applique non seulement aux producteurs commerciaux, mais aussi à tous les particuliers ou organismes qui mettent en circulation des publications ou des enregistrements sonores "en vue d'une distribution ou vente publiques", pour reprendre les termes de la *Loi sur la Bibliothèque nationale*. Le dépôt légal représente la méthode la plus pratique et la plus efficace de constituer une vaste collection nationale.



QUELS SONT LES AVANTAGES DU DÉPÔT LÉGAL?

Les documents reçus en vertu du dépôt légal viennent enrichir la collection nationale permanente. Elle est conservée à la Bibliothèque nationale pour les générations futures et peut être consultée sur place. L'étude de tous les aspects de la société canadienne est ainsi facilitée, au profit du grand public et de ceux qui s'intéressent aux recherches spécialisées ou à la culture.

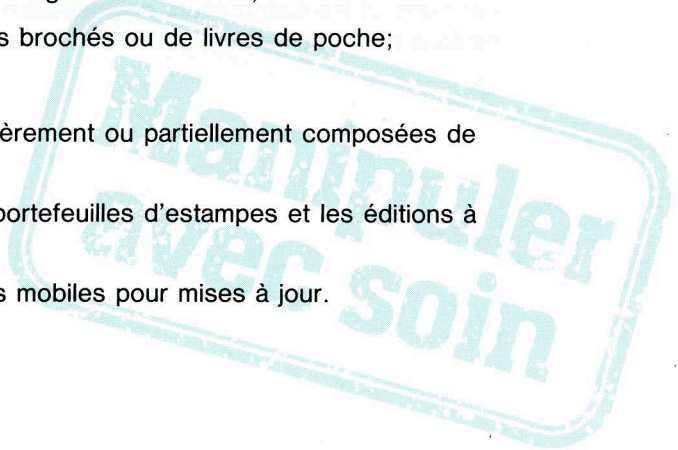
La plupart des publications et enregistrements provenant du dépôt légal sont aussi répertoriés et décrits dans *Canadiana*. Cette bibliographie, qui est constamment mise à jour, documente sur la production des éditeurs et compagnies d'enregistrements sonores canadiens. Elle sert d'outil de référence pour les recherches bibliographiques et pour la préparation de commandes au Canada comme à l'étranger. Il est donc primordial que les publications et les enregistrements sonores soient envoyés à la Bibliothèque nationale dès leur mise en circulation. Une notice dans *Canadiana* constitue un atout publicitaire important pour les auteurs, éditeurs, compositeurs et musiciens: les chercheurs y voient les dernières parutions et les distributeurs commerciaux y trouvent les informations nécessaires pour placer des commandes.

À QUELS DOCUMENTS LE DÉPÔT LÉGAL S'APPLIQUE-T-IL?

Éditeurs de livres: en vertu de la *Loi sur la Bibliothèque nationale*, les éditeurs de livres sont tenus de faire parvenir à la Bibliothèque des exemplaires des documents qui a) sont entièrement ou partiellement produits au Canada, **ou** qui b) portent l'adresse bibliographique d'un éditeur canadien sur la page de titre. Les éditeurs doivent envoyer les exemplaires à leurs propres frais dans la semaine suivant la mise en circulation, et ce, sans que la Bibliothèque nationale n'ait à en faire la demande.

Doivent être soumis en deux exemplaires:

- les ouvrages d'intérêt général traitant de n'importe quel domaine;
- les manuels portant sur n'importe quel sujet;
- les publications des associations professionnelles ou philanthropiques, des sociétés savantes, des maisons d'enseignement et de toutes autres organisations;
- tous les genres d'ouvrages de référence;
- les éditions de livres brochés ou de livres de poche;
- les brochures;
- les publications entièrement ou partiellement composées de musique;
- les livres d'art, les portefeuilles d'estampes et les éditions à tirage limité;
- les cahiers à feuilles mobiles pour mises à jour.



Doivent être soumis en un seul exemplaire:

- les livres dont la valeur au détail excède cinquante dollars;
- les ensembles éducatifs aussi composés de non-livres.

Au moins un des exemplaires envoyés à la Bibliothèque nationale doit être de la meilleure qualité produite. Ainsi, s'il existe une édition reliée et une édition brochée, au moins un exemplaire de l'édition reliée doit être envoyée.

Éditeurs de périodiques: en vertu de la *Loi sur la Bibliothèque nationale*, les éditeurs sont tenus de faire parvenir à la Bibliothèque des exemplaires des périodiques, des annuaires et autres publications en série qui a) ont été entièrement ou partiellement produits au Canada, **ou** qui b) portent l'adresse bibliographique d'un éditeur canadien sur la page de titre ou dans la cartouche de titre. Dans la **semaine suivant** la mise en circulation d'une publication, l'éditeur doit envoyer à ses propres frais **deux** copies de chaque numéro, et ce, sans que la Bibliothèque nationale n'ait à en faire la demande. **Un** seul exemplaire de chaque numéro doit être déposé lorsque le tarif annuel d'abonnement dépasse cinquante dollars.

Éditeurs de microformes: En vertu de la *Loi sur la Bibliothèque nationale*, les éditeurs de microformes sont tenus de faire parvenir à la Bibliothèque nationale des exemplaires des publications sur microforme publiées après le 1^{er} janvier 1988 qui a) ont été entièrement ou partiellement produits au Canada, **ou** qui b) portent l'adresse bibliographique d'un éditeur canadien. Dans la **semaine suivant** la mise en circulation d'une publication, l'éditeur doit envoyer à ses propres frais **deux** copies de chaque œuvre, et ce, sans que la Bibliothèque nationale n'ait à en faire la demande. **Un** seul exemplaire de chaque œuvre doit être déposé lorsque la valeur au détail ou le tarif annuel d'abonnement dépasse cinquante dollars.

Compagnies d'enregistrements sonores: en vertu de la *Loi sur la Bibliothèque nationale*, les compagnies d'enregistrements sonores doivent faire parvenir à la Bibliothèque nationale les disques, bandes magnétiques, disques compacts et autres enregistrements sonores dont le contenu est canadien, qui ont un intérêt pour le pays (par exemple, les enregistrements dont le compositeur, l'artiste, le chef d'orchestre, l'orchestre ou que d'autres éléments sont canadiens) et qui ont été produits au Canada. La compagnie est tenue d'envoyer, à ses propres frais, **un** exemplaire de l'enregistrement dans la **semaine suivant** sa mise en circulation, et ce, sans que la Bibliothèque nationale n'ait à le demander.

COMMENT RESPECTER LE RÈGLEMENT SUR LE DÉPÔT LÉGAL?

Les éditeurs et les compagnies d'enregistrements sonores sont tenus en vertu de la loi d'envoyer des exemplaires de leurs publications et de leurs enregistrements sonores à la Bibliothèque nationale. Afin que le processus fonctionne le mieux possible, les éditeurs et compagnies d'enregistrements sonores devraient:

- faire parvenir les documents dans la **semaine suivant** leur mise en circulation;
- inscrire la Bibliothèque nationale sur leurs listes d'organismes et de particuliers qui reçoivent automatiquement des exemplaires de service de presse ou de publicité;
- remplir le formulaire "Publication à inscrire dans *Canadiana*" ou "Enregistrement sonore à inscrire dans *Canadiana*" pour chaque document envoyé à la Bibliothèque nationale. Ces formulaires ainsi que des étiquettes d'adresse peuvent être obtenus à la Bibliothèque nationale.

La Bibliothèque nationale du Canada émet des reçus pour tous les documents qui lui sont envoyés en vertu du dépôt légal.

Les éditeurs du Québec doivent aussi remettre des exemplaires de leurs publications à la Bibliothèque nationale du Québec.

Le dépôt légal n'est pas lié au droit d'auteur. Les questions concernant le droit d'auteur doivent être transmises au Bureau du droit d'auteur et des dessins industriels, Consommation et Corporations Canada, Ottawa (Ontario) K1A 0C9, numéro de téléphone: (819) 997-1726.

Material received on legal deposit is preserved in the Library's permanent collection, where it is available for consultation and research, and most titles are also listed in Canadiana, the national bibliography.

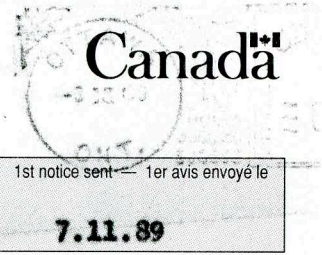
