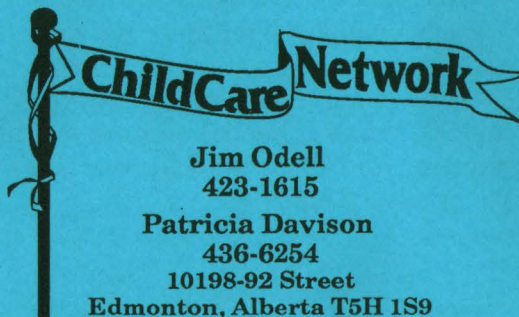

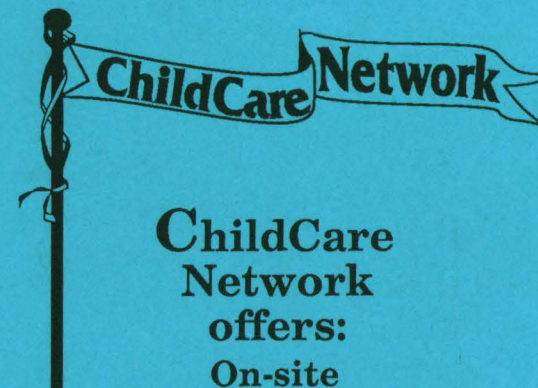

First contact

At the event

When families arrive they will find an attractive, well-equipped area. Children will be invited to play by staff who will introduce them to a variety of play opportunities, easing the separation from parents. Parents will register children providing staff with pertinent information regarding individual needs. Children will enjoy planned activities, equipment which is of interest to their age level, a light snack and possibly a meal. Experienced staff will anticipate needs and facilitate play in such a way that children quickly become comfortable and secure.

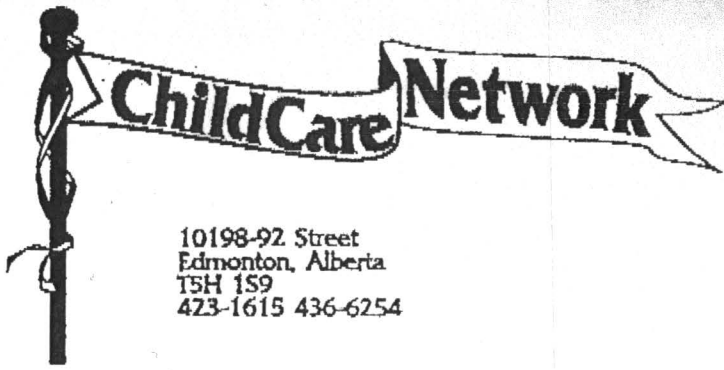
When parents return they will discover their children involved in play and eager to share experiences. Parents often comment on how much they appreciate feeling secure that their children have had an enjoyable experience.

Here is the information about our services.
You may want to copy the pamphlet and
enclose it in your registration letters.

Our staffing is in proportion to numbers and
ages of children. Closer to your event when
this information is known I will be able to give
you an estimate of the cost. Our ratio is one
to one for infants and toddlers under two years
of age, one to three for children 2 yrs - 3 yrs olds,
one to six for 3 yrs to 5 year olds, 5+ is one to
eight. We send out a minimum of 2 staff.
one staff for classes with the organization @ \$12⁰⁰ per hour
The rest of the staff to make up child care ratios
@ \$10⁰⁰ per hour.

There is also a fee for set-up and take down,
use of materials and equipment, along with a
management fee. If you have any questions feel
free to call me 436-6254.
